## Shopmobility Services



## What is Shopmobility?

Shopmobility is a scheme that loans manual and powered wheelchairs and powered scooters to members of the public who have limited mobility. These can be used to visit facilities in the local area.

Staff and volunteers will help you to decide what equipment to hire and ensure that you receive training to use it safely.

## Who can use Shopmobility?

Anyone with limited mobility. So whether you have a permanent impairment, have broken your ankle or are pregnant these services are available to you.

## Membership

A membership scheme is in operation at both Centres.

You pay an annual joining fee then a discounted fee each time you use a piece of equipment. Casual users are welcome and are charged for each visit.

It is advisable to pre-book equipment by phoning the Shopmobility Centre.



## Small Aids

The Birkenhead Centre sells a small range of disability aids including blue badge holders, radar keys, adjustable walking sticks, ferrules and offer a photograph service that can be used for passes and application forms.

If you don't see what you're looking for in our Centre, our staff will be happy to assist you with any questions or queries you have.

## Long term loans

Manual wheelchairs can be loaned overnight to a maximum of 4 weeks. A deposit is required and a charge applies for this service.

## Scooter Repair Service

At our Liscard Centre, we have the facility to offer a scooter repair service. We can fix:

- ◆ Punctures
- ◆ Battery problems
- ◆ Minor faults
- ◆ Bodywork damage
- ◆ Tyres
- ◆ Brakes

Please note we do not carry out electrical repairs.
